TAKE EXTRA CAUTION AROUND LAKES, STREAMS, RIVERS AND STORMWATER PONDS

Take caution around local bodies of water such as Fairy Lake, the Holland River and stormwater ponds. Use extreme caution and advise your children to not to skate, fish, swim or toboggan in these areas. Stormwater ponds may look safe but water flow and levels can fluctuate quickly without warning. Please do not skate on stormwater ponds.

NEWMARKET SNOW PLOWING PROCEDURES

Newmarket snow crews plow sidewalks and local roads in Newmarket. Regional roads such as Mulock, Bayview, Yonge are maintained by York Region. Plowing operations begin once snow accumulates over 6cm and the focus will be primary roads first. Please remember:

- Do not push snow into the streets or sidewalks
- Do not put waste and recycling bins on the street or sidewalk
- Do not park your cars on the street as this interferes with snow plowing operations
- Please report and damages to info@newmaket.ca
- Please respect our snow operators

NEED EXTRA PARKING THIS WINTER?

The free Off-Street Parking program is back! With a permit, you can park in select municipal lots overnight between the hours of 5 p.m. to 7 a.m. while winter parking restrictions are in effect. It's easy:

- 1. Go to our online parking portal
- 2. Put in your vehicle information
- 3. Park in one of four Municipal lots, in a designated spot
- 4. Move your car by 7 a.m.
