#### ANNUAL WATERMAIN CLEANING NEWMARKET

The Town's Annual Watermain Cleaning program is underway so we can continue to provide safe, highquality water to residents. Unidirectional flushing (UDF) will be used to clean the watermains by flushing sequences of water from one hydrant to another.

In most cases, you will not notice any change in service. However you may notice discolouration in the water and/ or low water pressure. Discoloured water does not pose a health hazard. If this occurs, residents can run their faucets for a short time until the water is clear.
